BTA'S CATCH UP

UPGRADES TO OFFICES

In the 2023, BTA is excited to be making upgrades to our offices to help further support our students and families.

Sensory and **Fidget Toys** will be available in the Offices in early Term 1 for students to freely use to aid in sensory stimulation, self regulation and focus. All students are encouraged to use these as they wish! Further, we will be introducing **Student Amenities Boxes** in Term 1. These boxes include sanitary products such as pads, tampons, hair ties and hair brushes and floss that students may freely access if they ever have need for any of these items.

PAYMENTS

At BTA, we invoice fortnightly on Tuesdays for lessons that took place in the 2 weeks prior.

There are numerous ways to pay the invoices, including credit card, debit card and direct debit. We pass on a small fee for credit or debit card purchases, but we do not charge a fee for direct debit.

Auto payment can easily be set up from any invoice, simply click the box that says "debit me automatically for future payments." All auto payments are processed on the invoice due date.

Unfortunately, **we will not be continuing the BTA Multiple Family Discount in 2023.**

2023 SERVICE OPTIONS

In 2023 we have diversified and streamlined our service options into the 2 following categories, **Pay as You Go** and **Term Packages**.

The new **Term Packages** option includes the following exciting features;

- **Pay for 10 lessons upfront at the beginning of each school term** (\$750 for Students in Years 3-10, and \$900 for Students in Years 11-12)
- Our New **Platinum Term Package** gives access to **20 lessons a term** for \$1750, perfect for students who are tutored in multiple subjects!
- All **Term Packages** come with optional add-ons, such as our **Assessment** and **Organisation Sessions**, led by one of BTA's **Head Tutors**, who have **Over 3000 hours tutoring experience**.
- This payment option is **only valid prior to the start of each school term**. Full payment must be received by the end of the first week of the school term.
- **Credits expire 2 weeks after end of term**
- If a student requires **extra sessions** on top of their allocated package, they **will be invoiced fortnightly at our normal PAYG rate**.
- **Packages are per student** and cannot be split across families.


The **iPad 9th Gen** features an all-day battery life, a 10.2 inch screen as well as incredible processing and graphics performance.

NAPLAN- WHAT, AND WHY?

NAPLAN, or the National Assessment Program- Literacy and Numeracy, is a standardised test made to assess schools effectiveness in their teaching as well as ensuring students are meeting minimum standards.

The NAPLAN is held in **Years, 3, 5, 7 and 9**, and **as of 2016, students must reach a Band 8 in all of their Year 9 NAPLAN papers to be eligible for the HSC.**

The Year 3 NAPLAN tests are the first time parents are able to see how their child is comparing against their peers both from within the school and against the national average. Going forward in years 5, 7 and 9, you will be able to compare each year's results to see the progress your child is making under the headings assessed in NAPLAN, that is reading, writing, language conventions and numeracy.

HOW TO PREPARE

Unlike most exams, NAPLAN is **not content driven**, meaning that you can't memorise dates, quotes, formulas etc in order to pass. Rather, it is a **skill driven exam**, meaning that it tests students on their application of **literacy and numeracy skills** in the form of **multiple choice, reading and written responses.**

The best way to prepare for the NAPLAN is to **do past papers** in order to test your skills against the kinds of questions that they're likely to ask!

At BTA, as with any specialised and targeted one-on-one tuition, **tutoring for NAPLAN can be super useful** particularly when the focus is on familiarising students with the set-out of the NAPLAN test as well as teach students about proper **examination technique.**

Further, **tutoring can be used to target specific target areas identified in your child's NAPLAN results**, ensuring your child feels confident in the years ahead.

THE YEAR 9 NAPLAN

In the Year 9 NAPLAN, students must achieve a Band 8 in literacy and numeracy in order to receive their HSC.

If you don't achieve a Band 8 in these assessments, students will be able to access online literacy and numeracy tests **twice a year** up until their HSC, and as long as they pass one of these, they're good to go!

If you don't achieve a Band 8 by Year 12, you still sit the HSC exams as normal, but only receive a **Record of School Achievement**, and then have **5 years** to meet the minimum standard and receive the your official Higher School Certificate.

HOW DO SCHOOLS AND TEACHERS USE NAPLAN RESULTS?

Data collected from the NAPLAN examinations can be used by schools and teachers to compare their students to a wider group across Australia, or even, compare their students to similar students in their local demographic.

Further, the results can identify students who may require additional support, ensuring no student is left behind.

Overall, the results may be best used by schools to compare their own learning programs and systems year-on-year. More specifically, schools can use these results to identify strengths and weaknesses and develop academic goals for the years ahead.




- Have fun!**





